The position is domiciled in the Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics in the Faculty of Health Sciencies, under the Monitor and Prevent Antimicrobial Resistance in Kenya (MAP-AMR Kenya) Project. This is a five (5) year CDC project that will be conducted in three (3) hospitals: namely Kenyatta National Hospital, The Nairobi Hospital and The National Spinal Injury Referral Hospital.

Location

This is a full time position based at the University of Nairobi, Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics, its holder reports to the Project Principal Investigator.

Duties and Resposnbilites

- Support the implementation of IPC recommendations and AMR stewardship action plans in the project health facilities to assist with antibiotic selection for common clinical conditions
- ii) Participate in the development of SOPs, clinician handbooks, mentorship framework and guideline documents
- iii) Assist in the development of campaign material on the risk of AMR as per the project's objectives
- iv) Support the coordination of AMR surveillance activities
- v) Support data collection on antimicrobial consumption and use in the project sites

- vii) Assist the Prncipal Investigator and the project's Technical Experts to prepare technical progress reports on project implementation and achievements
