Applicants must be holders of either B.Sc. or Higher Diploma in any of the following areas: Biological or Medical Laboratory Sciences or equivalent qualification from a recognized learning Institution. They should have three (3) years experience as Technologist grade ABC.

Experience working in gross, microscopic, developmental anatomy laboratories, in a mortuary and possession of a special skill in preparation of specimens for training in surgical skills, (for Human Anatomy); computer literacy and knowledge of software data acquisition and processing in basic physiology measurements (for Medical Physiology) will be an added advantage

The successful candidate will among other assignments be expected to organize student practical sections in the allocated laboratory(ies); either the Human Anatomy or Medical Physiology Laboratory; participate in students projects and research activities in the allocated laboratory, Service equipment and maintain both equipment and supplies for the laboratories and respective services, participate in procurement and supervise other subordinate technical support in the department. Those allocated the human anatomy laboratory will also to organize and ensure collection and disposal of cadavers for teaching purposes.
